

RULES

- Each artist may only apply in one category. Work that is exhibited must be compatible with CD images. We reserve the right to request removal of work that is inconsistent with submitted CD and implied quality of work.
- Work must be of original concept, design and execution. No commercially manufactured work may be sold. No copies, reproductions, novelties, crafts or kits.
- Jewelers must be the designers and hands-on makers of their work. Please note on CD image description if beads are handmade.
- Artist must be present with his/her work for duration of festival.
- Each artist is responsible for collection and payment of the 6% Michigan Sales Tax.
- No pets are allowed with exhibitors.
- Booth Size:
10' x 10' (physical space of 12' x 12' for set-up)
10' x 20' (physical space of 12' x 24' for set-up)
**Limited number of double booths available*
- The Lowell Area Arts Council requests that artist statements & photos be posted in exhibiting artist booth. (not required)
- Jury Procedure: A committee made up of Lowell Area Arts Council community artists and volunteers will select artists based on CD submitted for entry. **A new committee is selected each year** and the jury process is anonymous. The goal of this committee is to invite a diverse range of artists with broad representation of art media and creativity within media. ***Prior acceptance to Fallasburg Fall Festival will not guarantee future acceptance.***
- All parts of the application requirements **must** be followed. ***The Lowell Area Arts Council reserves the right to reject any registration entry that is not complete.***
- The Lowell Area Arts Council has an established policy to provide equal opportunity to participate in and benefit from all programs, activities, and services without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, or handicap.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

- Complete all parts of the Application Form
- Submit 3 to 5 digital JPEG images on a CD. One image must represent a fully stocked booth set-up. **You must include an image of your booth.** Artwork on CD of booth image must represent the same artworks. **Your image is very important! Please include the highest quality JPEG on your CD you can produce. (5x7 300dpi is adequate)**
- **Photographs and Slides are not accepted.**
- Label each image with your name and a number to correspond with the CD description on the application form.
- Complete CD description / digital image section
- **Payment:** Two Checks. US currency only, payable to the Lowell Area Arts Council: nonrefundable \$15 administration fee, and \$175 or \$300 booth fee.
- **SASE:** Envelope with adequate postage for return of your CD. CD's of accepted work will be returned during Festival.

The Fallasburg Fall Festival is a unique event that develops the potential of an extraordinary historical setting. This annual arts festival is held in and around the pavilion area at the west end of Fallasburg Park. Spanning the Flat River between the park and Fallasburg Village is the picturesque Fallasburg Covered Bridge, erected in 1871. The Old Schoolhouse Museum, at the east end of the village, will be open during festival, and the park itself provides many picnic areas and beautiful sight-seeing opportunities.

The Fallasburg Fall Festival brings in thousands of visitors from the greater Grand Rapids area and Lower Michigan. It is highly supported by the local community. The Festival features 85 exhibiting artists, musical entertainment, children's art activities, raffle tickets for wonderful prizes, demonstrations of traditional arts and crafts, and great food. The historical atmosphere and family fun will surely draw a large crowd again this year.
